Bruce McCuaig becomes President and Chief Executive Officer of Metrolinx, the regional transportation authority for the Greater Toronto and Hamilton Area, on September 4, 2010.

Mr. McCuaig is, at present, the Ontario Deputy Minister of Transportation. As Deputy Minister he leads 4,000 public servants to help ensure Ontario's transportation system is efficient in safely moving people and goods.

Bruce McCuaig has a 26-year record of public service in the transportation and land-use planning sectors. He has successfully risen through the ranks in the Ontario Public Service, serving first in the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing and the last 15 years in the Ministry of Transportation. Prior to becoming the Ontario Deputy Minister of Transportation, Bruce McCuaig headed the Provincial Highways Management Division of the Ministry, which is the Ministry's largest operating division. Mr. McCuaig has also held the position of Assistant Deputy Minister of the Policy, Planning and Standards Division of the Ministry of Transportation. This combination of operating, planning and policy experience perfectly matches the needs of Metrolinx with its broad mandate for the region and special responsibilities for GO Transit.

Mr. McCuaig has a Bachelor of Applied Arts degree in Urban and Regional Planning from Ryerson University, and a Master's degree in Public Administration from Queen's University.
